The **Farm Manager** is responsible for developing and enhancing the organic sustainability of the school farm and household needs, oversees crop and livestock production in the farm and ensures that farm activities are ecologically sustainable. The position also facilitates the documentation of farming practices to be translated into learning materials and methods for conducting training courses on organic agriculture.

Job Responsibilities:

1. Directing and coordinating farm activities: planning, composting, planting, maintaining crop and animal health and harvesting
2. Maintaining and monitoring the quality of yield, whether crops or livestock
3. Understanding the implications of the weather and making contingency plans
4. Ensuring that land use activities comply with ecological and organic sustainable practices
5. Documenting sustainable practices in crop and livestock production
6. Implementing a system for tracking and monitoring food production and consumption of the APC school campuses
7. Applying health and safety standards across the farm
8. Maintaining and repairing farm tools and equipment
